Proposed Relocation

While every effort has been made to relocate the market to the new Kiewa Street Carpark site we cannot yet have access to the site.

The move has now had to be postponed until next year.

Because infrastructure works by Rotary are still required we are now planning the launch to take place on Sunday 4th February 2018.

A sewer extension is being installed by Albury City Council to allow construction of toilets for our exclusive use. Additional lighting is to be installed to improve visibility for all stallholders and customers.
